TABISSO promotes cutting-edge yet relevant aesthetics for workspace and hospitality projects, working with talented and international designers to imagine and realize uncompromising furniture pieces.

Present on the global market, TABISSO caters to an international audience of prestigious interior design studios and their high profile clients, of the likes of Hyatt, LHW or Four Seasons in the hospitality market, and Philipp Morris, Procore or BlaBlaCar in the office sector.

The underlying belief - TABISSO strives to offer extensive customization and bespoke services in order to grant clients, architects and interior designers all latitude and freedom to shape their projects true to their own vision.

Beyond the broad modularity of the edited collections, newly designed products are also done bespoke for specific projects. TABISSO has notably worked on prestigious venues such as the restaurant Ciel de Paris on the top floor of Tour Montparnasse, for which the whole furniture set was realized based on the vision of the French star interior designer Noé Duchaufour Lawrance. More recently, a collaboration with American designer Michael Sean Stolworthy resulted in the production of bespoke cast-aluminum bar stools for the giant cruise ship Oasis Harmony of the Seas, making use of a leading-edge technology in 3d-printing the molds in order to cast the highly complex shaped stools.

TABISSO deeply believes in the virtues of a sustainable economy. Beyond their holistic eco-design approach, their manufacturing is handled fully in France to cut back on environmental impacts and to promote local employment. And also because they enjoy being in touch with passionate and skillful people underlying every one of their products.
